Blues in the Schools (BITS)

Since our inception in 2010 one of our major goals has been to educate the area youth about the great American art form known as the Blues.

Our Blues In The Schools (BITS) Program includes a school-wide assembly with professional musicians performing the Blues and MC'd by a PhD student in African-American history who shares an age-appropriate history of the Blues. Also, a small number of free Hohner harmonicas are shared with each school to distribute as they see fit.

We've held one day BITS programs in area libraries as well as 3 to 6 week after-school programs at Martin Luther King, Kenwood, South Side, Bottenfield, Thomas Paine, Garden Hills, Wiley Schools and Don Moyer's Boys & Girls Club. During the 2013 Champaign Blues, Brews & BBQ fest we sponsored workshops on harmonica playing and percussion instruments.
